Neighborhood Pro - September Gardening Tips

After the long hot, rainy summer, your lawn needs a feeding. Now is the time to fertilize it with a slow-release fertilizer only, and product labeled for your specific type of lawn. Be sure and follow the label instructions on amount to apply and watering in.

This is also the time to prune cold-hardy shrubs and perennials, or even pull them out and replace if they've succumbed to the summer's heat and humidity. The cool weather perennials should be appearing in the garden centers in a few weeks. When pruning, make the cut at the branch angle or bud, and about a foot above where you want the new branches to begin to fill in. Cut off the dead blooms and lanky stems to reshape them. To make clean up easier, carry a large bucket or large nursery pot around with you to gather up the clippings as you go. Now is also the time to give them a fall feeding, with a slow-release general 6-6-6, or similar ration, garden fertilizer (Ozmocote, Shake and Feed, etc).

And don't forget the invasive vines that are still growing strong. The especially odious Skunk Vine will be blooming soon, resulting in seeds being spread all over the place. Stop this monster now!

The city launched a new online service, @YourRequest. This new service is accessible from cityofwinterpark.org/AtYourRequest and will allow users to easily submit questions and requests for city services right from their mobile device or computer. Upon submission, requests will be routed to the appropriate city department to address.

Users can also quickly find an extensive log of Frequently Asked Questions with common answers. Examples of what can be reported using @YourRequest are:

- Broken or cracked sidewalks Code compliance concerns

- Non-emergency issues
- Power outages (or call 1-877-811-8700)
- Repair or maintenance of city facilities or amenities
- Utility turn on and off services
