100 Years Ago in 1922...

- Rebecca Felton of Georgia takes the oath of office, becoming the first woman United States Senator
- Following the passing of the newspaper Winter Park Post, the Winter Park Herald is started
- Vegemite is invented by Australian entrepreneur Fred Walker
- The Molly Pitcher Club (named after Molly Pitcher, a Revolutionary War folklore heroine) is formed to promote the repeal of Prohibition in the United States
- The Barbary lion becomes extinct in the wild, with the last killed in Morocco, and the Amur tiger becomes extinct in South Korea
- The Alabama Hotel on Palmer Ave. in Winter Park, with 80 rooms on four floors, is completed. Today the building operates as an upscale condominium, but the original 1920s hotel facade remains.
- Winter Park town doctor R.F. Hotard is authorized to vaccinate the town for smallpox
- Charles Schultz the American cartoonist who created the comic strip Peanuts, is born on November 26 in Minneapolis, MN. He died in 2000.

Place your luminaries on the curb by 6 p.m. on Dec 24. (Rain date Dec. 25)

FALL GARDENING TIPS BY BOARD MEMBER & ORANGE CO. MASTER GARDENER PENNY POTTER

Finally, the weather has moderated somewhat, and it is now time to grow greens, broccoli, kale, and collards. These veggies are easy to grow, and so nice to pick fresh for your salad right out of the ground (or pot). You can find transplants at all the garden centers. It is also time to toss the warm weather annuals and refresh your pots and beds with cool weather annuals, which should be in the garden centers now, as well.

Those mums that you may have bought for Halloween and Thanksgiving can still give you nice fall and winter color. Deadhead the spent blooms, give them a light dose of fertilizer and, in a few weeks, they will bloom again. Deadheading is a good way to keep most flowering plants neat and tidy, and to get them to re-bloom.
