Centennial Celebration and More

2024 was a busy year as we prepared for our Centennial Celebration year that started in November. Graphic artist Rick Kilby created a new OMW logo and one for the centennial. One of the new logos ended up on new event signs, T shirts, the Centennial cake, and this newsletter.

In the spring we wrapped up six block parties held on blockaded streets throughout our neighborhood. They were organized by Block Party Organizers Matt Daley, Tracy Hadley, Jimmy Hendrickson, Shawn Layton, Kerry Merrigan Falconer, Mark Snedeker, Richard and Vanessa Verkaik, Leslie Williams, and myself.

The November Centennial Celebration event filled The Park at Orwin Manor with neighbors and a few dignitaries including Winter Park Mayor Sheila DeCiccio and Commissioner Kris Cruzada. Neighbors pitched in for a banner, large yummy sheet cake (1/2 carrot and 1/2 chocolate), and OMW centennial themed coasters, stickers, and magnets. The food truck was a big hit. Residents who have called OMW home for ten years or more were recognized.

I wrote the text for and ordered two historic markers with one coming from Winter Park and one from the State of Florida. In early 2025, the markers will be installed with one in The Park at Orwin Manor and one in the tiny park on Orange Avenue across from Commerce Bank & Trust.

2025 appears to be the year for the budgeting of the replacement of the missing gateway arches as we prepare plans and a construction estimate for the City of Winter Park.

The FDOT Orange Avenue Lane Reduction project is almost complete as we wait for clean-up and activation of the crosswalk flashing beacons. Once the mast arms are installed at the Orlando Avenue intersection the additional left turn lane will be opened. It was December 31st 2017 when the fatal accident occurred and soon after we held a Traffic Summit to find a solution to the increasing traffic issues.



The inaugural Emeritus Orwin Manor Westminster Board Members and Honlorary Orwin Manor Westminsterites were announced at the Annual Meeting in January. 

Gardening Tip

Don't buy mulch! Take those falling leaves and use them to mulch your plants up to a 4-inch depth. Keep them a few inches away from trunks and plant stems. Leaves hold moisture in the soil, keep out weeds, encourage earthworms and add nutrients to the soil. Spread them and bag some for future use.
